



SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR XL AMERICA, INC. HEALTH AND WELFARE PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report of the XL America, Inc. Health and Welfare Plan (Employer Identification Number 06-1516268, Plan Number 501) for the plan year 01/01/2018 through 12/31/2018. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

XL America, Inc. has committed itself to pay certain health, flexible spending account, prescription drug, dental, vision, temporary disability, severance, and employee assistance program claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has insurance contracts with Aetna Life Insurance Company, XL Catlin Group USA, Cigna Health and Life Insurance Company and Affiliates, Federal Insurance Company, Life Insurance Company of North America, and Prudential Insurance Company of America to pay certain health, dental, vision, life insurance, accidental death and dismemberment, long term care, business travel accident, and long-term disability claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2018 were \$2,882,525.
